Data Driven Decisions: RBCES will strengthen our Tier II and Tier III systems of support.

- School teams will follow an established meeting schedule, structure and protocol using data to guide instructional decisions and monitor the implementation of tiers of support.
- School teams will regularly review data from common assessments (teacher created CFA, MAP, district assessments) to identify students for Tier II and Tier III supports. Data will be analyzed by individual student, standard, and learning targets in order to make instructional decisions.
