Goal 1 Collaborative Culture	 Ensure tier one system for behavior is implemented with fidelity school-wide to establish a sense of safety and belonging. Measurable outcome: If we implement a consistent school-wide tier one system of establishing a sense of safety and belonging we will reduce our office discipline referrals, and behavior calls for support by 20% Establish and teach school-wide routines and rituals to include BSS, greeting ritual, safekeeper ritual, friends and family board, classroom jobs, wish well ritual. Establish a Conscious Discipline Action Team Reteach school-wide expectations after each week-long break. Build strong family partnerships and trust with families. Ensure staff communicate with parents about their child's progress consistently and effectively.
Goal 2 Data Driven	 Use student output to drive tier 1,2,3 instruction and interventions. Measurable outcome: If we plan as a PLC intentionally for all tiers of instruction, with a focus on student output, then we will decrease the number of students needing tier 2 & 3 instruction by 20% Teachers will analyze the student output using the student work protocol aligned to GL benchmark. Create a system of ongoing progress monitoring for tier 2 & 3 that is shared between all stakeholders. Documents will include clear exit and entry requirements for data sources.
Goal 3 High Impact Instruction	 Benchmark Aligned Instruction: Teacher's instruction, scholar tasks, and assessments will be aligned to the grade level standards and students are released to do the work. Measurable outcome: If students task output is aligned to grade level standards, then students' proficiency will increase by 20% Teachers will provide students with benchmark-aligned tasks. Teachers will facilitate student-owned work in ELA, Math, and Science Teachers will use a sequence of questions that lead scholars to successfully complete the student task independently.
Goal 4 High Impact Instruction	 Student Engagement: Students will see the relevance in their work and will be actively engaged to the rigor of the benchmark. Measurable outcome: When students see the relevance in their work and are actively engaged to the rigor of the benchmarks, students' proficiency will increase by 20%. Students will utilize manipulatives and resources to support conceptual understanding of the benchmarks. Teachers will use total participation strategies and Kagan structures to increase engagement.
